DETAILS OF THE HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE IN ARTS

Subjects offered:

A) Compulsory subjects: English, MIL (Assamese)

B) Elective Subjects (Any four): Advance Assamese, Economics, Education, Geography, History, Home Science, Logic and Philosophy, Mathematics, Political Science and Sociology.

DETAILS OF THE HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE IN COMMERCE

Subjects Offered:

A) Compulsory subjects: English, MIL (Assamese), Accountancy, Business Studies.

B) Elective Subjects (Any two): Economics, Salesmanship and Advertising (SAAD), Finance; **Business Mathematics and Statistics or Mathematics.

** (Choose either Business Mathematics and Statistics or Mathematics)

DETAILS OF B.A. AND B.COM. PROGRAMME (CBCS)

CBCS: Choice Based Credit System is a flexible system of learning. 'Credit' defines the quantum of contents/ syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the number of hours of instruction required. This system permits students to learn at their own pace, choose electives from a wide range of Elective Courses offered for the programme, undergo additional courses and acquire more than the required number of credits, adopt an inter-disciplinary approach in learning, make best use of the expertise of available faculty.



Core Courses: Compulsory components of an Academic Programme. These Courses are to be compulsorily studied as a core requirement for the programme. The contents of the Core Courses shall be as per the UGC Model Curriculum for the subject/ discipline concerned.

Elective Courses: Elective courses shall be chosen by each student from a pool of courses. These courses may be intra-departmental, i.e. Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) as well as inter-departmental, i.e., Generic Elective (GE). The students shall have to choose minimum number of DSE and GE in every semester as prescribed in the Course Structure. These courses shall be:

- 1) supportive to the discipline of study
- 2) providing an expanded scope
- 3) enabling an exposure to some other discipline/ domain
- 4) nurturing student proficiency/ skill

Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): The Ability Enhancement Courses shall be of two kinds- ‘Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses’ and ‘Skill Enhancement Courses’. These courses shall be inter-disciplinary (within the Programme) in nature. ‘AEC’ Courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement.

ATTENDANCE

Minimum compulsory attendance is 80% during the total number of class days. A student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End-semester examination. Provided that it shall be open to the University to grant exemption to a student who has attended a minimum of 70% classes but failed to obtain the prescribed 80% attendance for valid reasons, on recommendation of the Principal of the College on payment of a prescribed fee(s). A student declared as discollegiate shall not be allowed to proceed to the next higher Semester. He/ She shall need to pursue the Semester afresh in which he/ she was declared as discollegiate along with the next fresh batch.



EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

- 1) Examination and evaluation shall be done on a continuous basis, at least three times during each semester.
- 2) There shall be 20% marks for internal assessment and 80% marks for End-semester examination in each course during every semester.
- 3) There shall be no provision for re-evaluation of the answer-scripts of the End-semester examinations. However, a candidate may apply for re-scrutiny.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION

1. Admission process to any programme/course will be purely online, as per Govt. instruction. All the rules (including Seat Reservation) of Govt. of Assam will be followed strictly in relation to admission.
2. Students should carefully read the prospectus before admission procedure.
3. All the students must submit transfer/Migration certificate from the competent authority in due time, as and when called for.
4. Students must give details of their Bank accounts correctly. Any anomalies or incorrectness in this, the college will not be responsible.
5. Every student must give and their permanent contact no and email ID so that the college can communicate with them easily. Further, information on anything in relation to teaching and learning and online notification from the college is sent through messages.
6. Admission will be fixed as per seat capacity in order to merit.
7. A merit list will be displayed in the website and college notice board, after verification of the applications

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Students have to browse the college website i.e. www.bihpuriacollege.edu.in. There will be display of online admission for submission of forms.
2. The students have to click on new online admission, there will be a form for admission. The students have to carefully enter their data as is asked by the form. After giving all details, there will be a submit button without payment. They should push that button. Form will be submitted and an acknowledgment receipt will come out. That acknowledgement slip must keep very carefully by the students.
3. After the last date of submission of forms, there will be display of merit list in the college notice board and in the website.
4. Selected students will have to take admission through online process, repeating the same procedure only after declaration of admission dates by the college authority, following the Govt. instruction.
5. The college will notify the updates in relation to admission from time to time.
6. The admitted students must submit a photocopy of admission slip in the college as and when called for. The admission slip must be kept carefully by the students. Once



lost, it cannot be regenerated again. College authority and website developers will not be responsible for any loss of admission slip details, acknowledgement slip, wrong entry in the form etc by the students.

7. No entertainment for any requests after last date of form submission and admission.

UNIFORM

Bihpuria College has stipulated uniform for Boys and Girls.
