Objectives of Today's Webinar are:

1. To lecture on the Paradigm shift of Marketing During and Post COVID Time by Dr Chimun Kr Nath; and
2. To Lecture on Redefining a new Economy Policy of Assam after COVID time by Mr Shymkanu Mahanta.

Speech by the Dr Chimun Kumar Nath (Associate Professor cum HOD Department of Commerce, Dibrugarh University):

Speech on “*Paradigm shift of Marketing during and after the Pandemic*”

During the pandemic what process the marketing is growing across the Globe? and

After the pandemic what the marketing will be growth across the Globe?

Market-driven economy.

The early 1980s and 1990s, the main aim was savings our money but after 2000 onwards situations have been changed we are purchasing goods or focus on expenditure. But at early, 2020 lots of changes have been taken place due to COVID-19 across the across including India. Our consumption patterns have also changed.

During the lockdown period, what are the activities taking place during the lockdown period under the four walls?

In this period we fully depend on technology, especially the internet. As a consumer, we are busier with using internet game, movies etc. Study shows that during the lockdown period the average internet user has spent 2.1 times more and therefore, it requires mobile data.

Due to lock down, peoples are focusing only on essential items, viz., grocery items, sensitiser, soap, mask, internet, etc.

During the pandemic situation demand of non-essential items are almost nil, so company are suffering a huge loss such as Toyota Company Ltd. This company has not sold a single unit in April, 2020. What they are doing no? They are using an advertisement in which they are showing services offered to their existing customer.

Speech by the Mr Shyamkanu Mahanta, (MD of MMS Advisory Company, Entrepreneur, analysis and social worker):

I will discuss on Economy, Entrepreneurship and Job creation after COVID in Assam. I have taken two initiative one is a project and the other one is tourism based entrepreneurship Jeypore Rainforest CITA surveyed Assam during the lockdown period:

-Around 50% peoples of Assam go down to BPL level;

-Around 70 lakh peoples have lost their livelihood because Main strength of Assam is tourism. After all, Assam has limited resource of crude oil and coal product Assam is not an optimum place for the large manufacturing industry.

We have to focus on tourism sector because NE has abundant tourism spot National parks Kaziranga, Manash Nameri etc), rain forest (Jeypore Rainforest), wildlife centuries, largest river Brahmaputra and its surrounding culture. It makes Assam most attractive destination across the world.

Govt. takes initiative and innovative steps for reviving the tourism sector. Now Govt. of Assam should contribute a certain amount of money to the small vendor, small businessman, small entrepreneur to recover their economic position. It will create a large economy in Assam.

We should focus on the Tea industry and agriculture sector in Assam.

Following are the selected Questions being asked by the Participants:

a. Mayank asked: In Assam, farmers do not have sufficient knowledge of modern agro-technology in cultivation. Sir, do you think that the Government should provide a modern farming technique to improve the agriculture sector in the state. Please comment on this.

Generally, in the state of Assam, cultivated land is being used a few months in a year and the remaining periods are lying vacant. Please suggest to us how to use those vacant land in an optimum way.

c. Jyotika Medok asked: Sir when we talk about Entrepreneurship we primarily target the unemployed ones for a start-up. Don't you think it's high time that the service holders should also be encouraged for Entrepreneurship, simultaneously, to boost the economy as a whole?

d. Nandan Sarmah asked: Sir do you think the young peoples of Assam are supposed to comfort with Western culture as compared to their own culture. What should we do in this context?

e. Mayank asked: if we can start-up new business but sir we don't have enough knowledge, for example, sir, if I start a seasonal business like mango juice And even if I have made it, then there is no supply support or who helps us to improve our new business and there are lots of problems have to face if we get any support then we don't fear to do anything.

f. Barasha Pathak was asked: Flood situations of Assam have not been solved ever after spending 30000 Cr on the embankment and still unchanged as it was earlier. Sir, Please highlight in this burning issue.

g. Bulbul Sahariah asked: sir don't we need a rigid policy to keep the business in our hand, for example, entire fancy Bazar, the heart of the business is completely out of our hand, can we develop an alternative parallel market near Guwahati?

h. Panchanan Barman asked: Only firming and engaging in cottage industry is not the ultimate solution due to the whole middlemen reaps the benefits such as if we observe that the market of bell metal industry in Sarthebari area middle man earns the maximum profit. What will be your opinion on it?




How do you rate the technical handling of the entire programme





Speech by Dr A. I. Chanu

Ma'am Indian govt has adopted various schemes like PMKVY, SANKALP with the objective of enhancing skill development and to increase employment opportunities. But there is a shortage of trained faculty in those institutions which become barrier to build a highly skilled workforce. My question is how could we overcome this huge gap and reap the benefit of skilled India schemes?

And: Mam told that one must be adaptive to changes and acquire a new skill with the ongoing time. She, cited the example of farmers who once used to work manually in the field but now it is overtaken by the new technologies.
